

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

The articles for the 3rd International Seminars "Architectures of the Soul" will be edited by DINÂMIA'CET-IUL, IEM, CHER and CHAIA, and gather in a publication with scientific revision, referenced with ISBN.

Authors should check the conformity of submitted articles with all items listed below.

1. The text must be original and unpublished and not under revision or have already been accepted for publication by another journal.

2. The proposed article should:

Be sent until 15 of September of 2020

Maximum length of 70,000 characters (including spaces) in Times New Romans 12pt

Be written in Portuguese, Spanish, French, English or Italian

Have an abstract (maximum 200 words) and 3-5 key words in Portuguese and English (as well as the language of the article, if different from this two).

Be sent in electronic format, processed in word or compatible file, and sent by email to arquitecturasdaalma@gmail.com.

Include a page referring to the title of the article, the author's name, the academic or professional institution to which it is linked, the postal and electronic address, and the telephone number.

3. References should be guided by Norma Portuguesa 405-1, of January of 1995.

Examples:

Azevedo. Vol. 3: Religião e Secularização. Coord. de Manuel Clemente; António Matos Ferreira. Lisboa: Círculo de Leitores, 2002, p. 399-501.

Artigos: Vanda Anastácio – Amenos desertos: em torno das éclogas de Frei Agostinho da Cruz. Lusitania Sacra. 11 (1999) 87-110.

In the case of bibliography and other resources available online, their addresses must be provided.

4. After the process of peer review, and once approved texts, the author will have access to the first proofs for correction. However, no significant changes are allowed to the original structure and original size of the text.

5. Images:

a) Images (max 10) must not exceed 160 mm x 160 mm and must have a minimum resolution of 300 dpi;

b) They can be in color or B / W: in the paper publication will be printed in black and white, and the e-book version in color; in the case of plans and maps, be aware that all the signs must be legible in black and white;

c) Tables should be sent in editable form (word) and, if possible, without notes;

d) Graphics or maps should also be sent in editable format;

e) Images should be sent in autonomous files, outside the text, in JPEG or TIF format, duly identified and numbered in the order they should appear in the article (eg: Figure 1); in the text, indicate in red the place of insertion of the images, tables, maps or pictures;

e) In word file, to the part, to insert all the captions of figures, tables, pictures, plants or maps. They should indicate the respective copyright, and it is the author's responsibility to ensure that all questions on this subject are resolved. In the caption, besides the description, indicate the origin of the image, the date and the authorship, especially when it does not belong to any of the authors of the text.
